



This is for up to one one-time \$1000

year.





Our son, Adam Benson, was a 2004 graduate from East Burke High School. He was very active in his school, in sports, his church, his family and his community. As he was returning from Freshman Orientation at East Carolina University he was involved in a motor vehicle accident and died June 15, 2004. Adam had many hopes and dreams of becoming a doctor. As a way to commemorate his memory we have formed The Adam Benson Memorial Scholarship. It is our hope that the recipient of this award will use it to further their education.

Eligibility criteria for applying for the \$1000 scholarship is as follows:

- Must be a senior graduating from high school or a graduate already attending college.
- Must have graduated with at least a 3.0 unweighted grade point average.
- Must be intending to pursue secondary education.
- Must be an active member of St. Charles Borromeo Catholic Church.
- Must be active in service to church and community.
