Financial need and character reflecting the commitment of Lions Club members are important criteria. **The objectives of Lions International are to create and foster a spirit of understanding among all people for humanitarian needs by providing voluntary service through community involvement and international cooperation.** Students living within Burke County, High School Seniors, enrolled college students or others planning to attend college for the first time are eligible to apply. **Applicants must have a 2.5 Grade Point Average.**
